Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Evangelism/Discipleship/Education, Hungary ~ The Reverend Carmella Jones serves in Hungary as a school chaplain through IM partner Hungarian Baptist Aid. In this position, Carmella acts as a listening presence and offer pastoral care to students, families and the school community. Carmella, a registered nurse and ordained ABCUSA pastor, is experienced in Faith Community Nursing, a specialty that promotes healing and health of mind, body and spirit through prevention and wellness education.

SBC Missionaries: William and Joy Jones (Lead Church Planter, Kagman Community Church and Church 360, Saipan, Northern Mariana Islands) ~ The church was born out of Disaster Relief Typhoon Soudelor—a category 4 typhoon-hit Saipan Aug. 2, 2015. They used the church space they were renting to start a feeding center. When they closed the feeding center in September, they were feeding more than 1,000 meals a day. They had their first service the **Sunday** after the feeding center closed. They were also given a baby church on the other side of the island. This traditional church is called Church 360 with around 40 people on a **Sunday**. Their goal is to reach people for Christ from all walks of life.

SBC Chaplaincy: SBC Chaplaincy: Chaplain, Captain Myung Cho, U.S. Air Force, Based: Osan AB, Republic of Korea ~ Pray that their newly launched ministry to single Airmen will result in revival. Pray for Protestant youth ministries, their praise team and contemporary service. Pray that he can balance time between ministry and family.
