Based in the Netherlands, she travels extensively throughout Europe, Asia, Africa and the Americas to teach, train and consult. In 2004, Lauran directed the first International Christian Alliance on Prostitution (ICAP) Global Conference, bringing together the leaders of faith-based organizations from all over the world who are dedicated to meeting victims of prostitution and human trafficking with healing in Jesus' name.

SBC Missionaries: Kimberly Carson (Collegiate/University Missionary) New Life, Cal U, California, PA, ~ Kimberly is a self-funded missionary from Florida who came to California, PA on the campus of California University of PA. She invests much of her time and energy into the spiritual growth of the Cal U students and community. It is her passion! In addition, she met her husband and partner in ministry on campus!

SBC Chaplaincy: Eric & Erin Clancy, Corporate Chaplaincy, Living Water Church, Poughkeepsie, NY ~ Erin Clancy's mission field is from the "Big Apple to the Capital," eastern New York State, NYC to Albany and beyond. He is also on alert for national crises and disasters as a rapid response chaplain. He is involved as a chaplain with the services for Veterans, Healthcare, Corporate, Community, and Law Enforcement also. Top campaign consists of veteran services: homeless, suicide prevention/intervention, and PTSD/mental health.

"Arise, and go down to the potter's house, and there I will cause thee to hear my words. Then I went down to the potter's house, and, behold, he wrought a work on the wheels. And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it."
