Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Carol Sydnor/Training & Capacity Building; Education/ Nepal ~ Carol serves as an International Ministries development worker for Nepal mission by maintaining the partner relationship of IM with three primary organizations: the Nepal Baptist Church Council, Human Development & Community Services, and United Mission to Nepal. Her primary responsibilities are to strengthen mission cooperation with IM partners in the country, to monitor Nepal earthquake relief and other IM projects, and to assist service arrangements for long- and short- term personnel in Nepal.

SBC Missionaries: Enrique Mendizabal (Lead Church Planter, The Hills Community Church, Porterville, CA) ~ Enrique and his family live in Porterville, which is a town of about 60,000 people and growing. However, their area is filled with poverty, lots of teen pregnancies, and a changing landscape of more and more unbelievers. Their mission is to see lives changed through the gospel of Jesus Christ, and they have definitely seen that happen. They primarily focus on reaching families and college-aged students. Since they launched more than a year ago, they have seen 55 confessions of faith and 15 baptisms of people from all ages, ethnicities, and backgrounds.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: Darrell Burriss (Military Chaplaincy, Vista del Sol Church, El Paso TX) ~ Darrell serves as a U.S. Army Chaplain on active duty. He has been at this for almost eight years and loves it. This is what Jesus created him to do for His kingdom at this time in his life. He is with soldiers and their families on the best days of their lives and the worst. He goes where his "congregation" goes--all day, every day. He would volunteer to do this without pay if that's what it took to continue being an Army Chaplain.
