To Schedule an event at our church

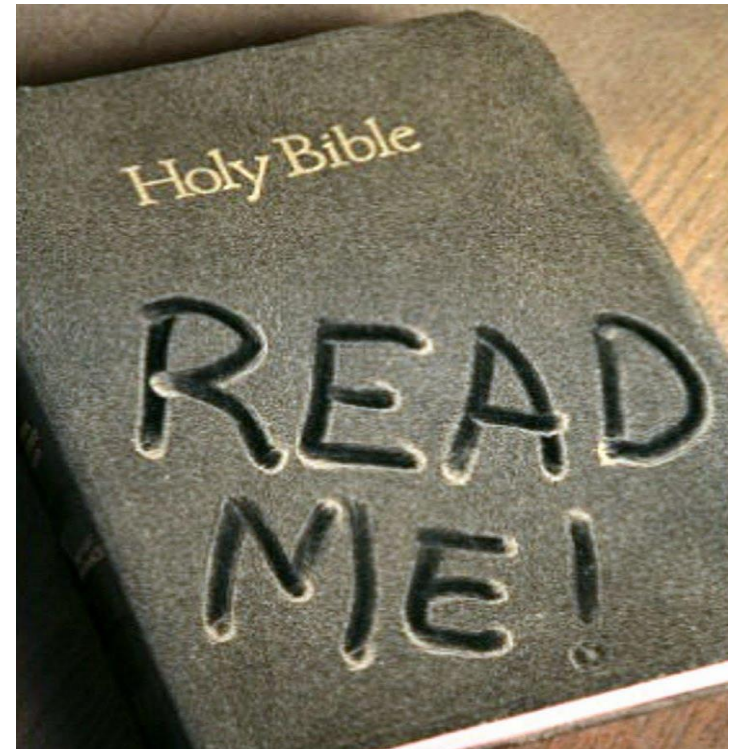
