Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Dilia Zelaya/Honduras ~ Dilia is an associate missionary appointed by International Ministries in partnership with the First Baptist Church of Marshalltown, Iowa. She develops and supervises the Ministries of Faith and New Life in Azacualpa, Honduras. This ministry is home to nine children, providing for all their food, education, health and spiritual growth. Dilia has founded the Escuela Cristiana Vida Nueva (Christian School of New Life), a bilingual school that includes a computer room, a feeding program that provides a meal five days a week to approximately 50 children in need and a soccer program dedicated to teenagers from the community.

SBC Missionaries: Brian Owen (Lead Church Planter, Grace City Church in Boston, Massachusetts) ~ Brian and Katy have a heart to see college-aged individuals and young adults evangelized, mobilized, and sent out. They also want to plant churches throughout New England through developing, training, and sending their young men and women who are called to plant.
