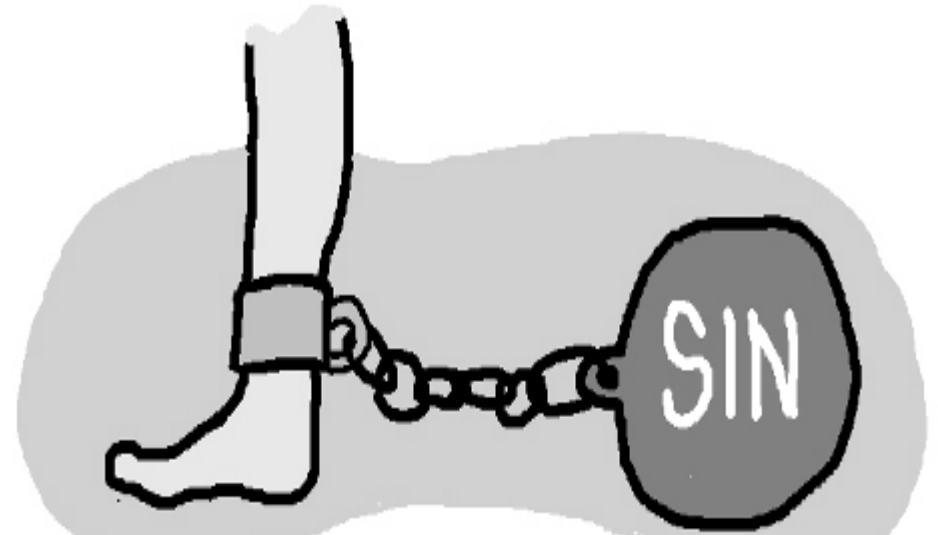

ABC International Ministries: Juan and Denise Aragon/Mexico ~ The Aragons serve in partnership with the Council of Rural Indigenous Evangelicals of Mexico in Chiapas, Mexico. They both work in training, prevention and education as they learn the community needs and look for ways to emotionally and economically empower leaders in their communities. Juan focuses on theological education and leadership training as he accompanies, coaches and disciples new church leaders. Denise's ministry is to help empower women who are victims of domestic abuse.

SBC Missionaries: Jay & Melissa Haynes (Lead Church Planter, Waiehu Community Church, Wailuku, HI) ~ Jay and Melissa recently launched Waiehu Community Church in January 2019 with the help of their Sending Church, Kahului Baptist. They hope to reach a community that is largely unengaged by a biblical church, but is inundated with prosperity gospel and Mormonism. Their partner in planting is Rocky Komatsu, who was born and raised in Maui.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: Tom & Kelly Allen (Military Chaplaincy, Catalyst Church, Newport, VA) ~ Tom and Kelly have been serving the U.S. Army since 2002. Tom is currently a Lieutenant Colonel and serving in the Washington, D.C., area.
