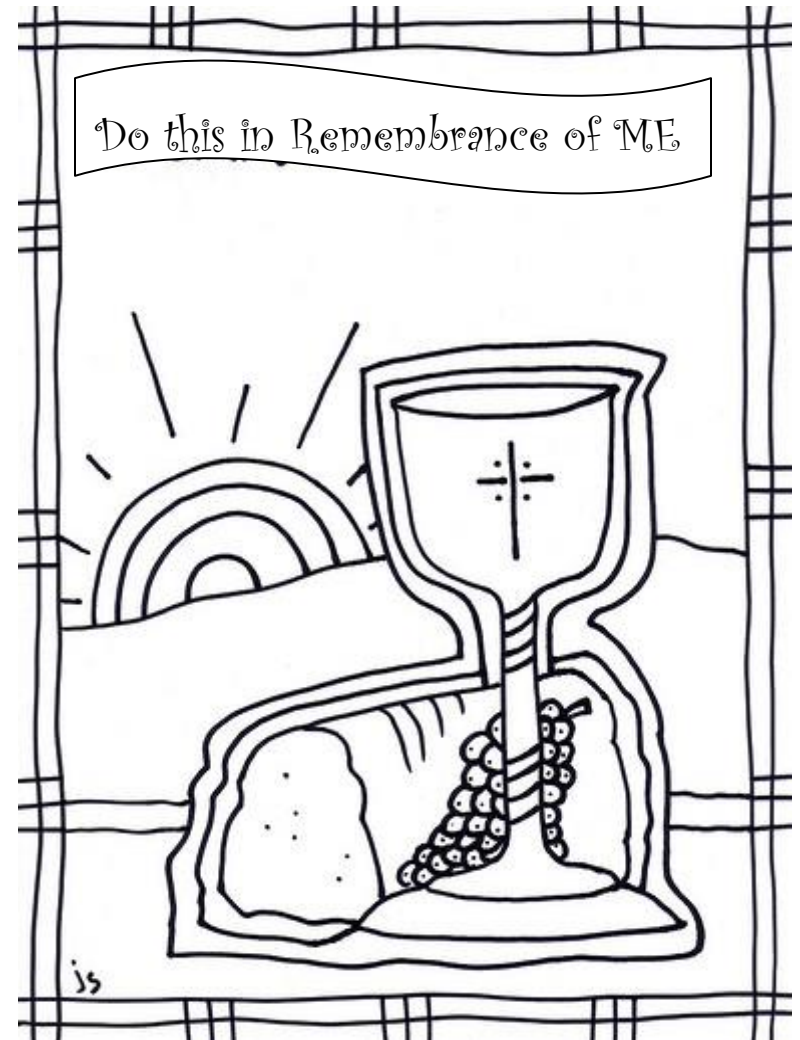

ABC International Ministries: Lauran Bethell/Global ~ Lauran is a global consultant for human trafficking. Her main goal is to encourage new grassroots projects addressing the exploitation and abuse of women and children, many of whom are victims of trafficking. Based in the Netherlands, she travels extensively throughout Europe, Asia, Africa and the Americas to teach, train and consult

SBC Missionaries: Shayne & Christina Robinson (Lead Church Planter, Redeemer Church, Waterloo, Illinois) ~ The Robinson's calling to plant a church in Waterloo grew out of living with the community for two years, where they saw the community's desperate lostness. Waterloo is a community of more than 10,000 souls. It moved them to plant there, when they realized that over 9,000 of those people are not in church and that many are in a church that do not preach the gospel.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: James Brown (Army Chaplain, Fort Hood, TX; Sending Church: First Baptist Church in Chandler, AZ) ~ The ministry is cross-cultural and a unique mission context for him. God continues to open doors to share Jesus and His redemption through the moves, temporary duty assignments and deployments.
