Missionary Emphasis:
ABC International Ministries: Dan & Sharon Buttry/Global ~ The Buttrys are global consultants (Dan for Peace and Justice and Sharon for Community Transformation). They serve around the world to provide consultation and training in conflict transformation and the transformation of communities, working primarily through the church as God's instrument of change. In the past nine years, Sharon and Dan have trained over 250 church and community leaders from 50 countries in 10-day Training of Conflict Transformation Trainers programs.

SBC Missionaries: Thomas Bevers (Russian Language Church Plant, Cincinnati, OH) ~ Thomas is planting a church among the Russian speaking immigrants of Cincinnati. He always clarifies that their ministry is to Russian speakers. After the break of the Soviet Union, there were many countries that became independent but still primarily speak the Russian language. Therefore, their ministry encompasses people from many different countries as well as different faiths. Their goal is to overcome some barriers that exist between these people while at the same time, winning as many to Christ as possible and incorporating them into a body of believers from a variety of lands, a variety of faiths all living in a country not their own.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: Jeffrey Herron/GA ~ Jeffrey serves God and country as a chaplain with the Georgia Army National Guard. He is serving our service members as: (1) 1/214 Field Artillery BN Chaplain and (2) Regional Care Chaplain out of the state chaplain's office.
