Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Aphiwan & Scott Coats/Myanmar, Thailand/Training & Capacity Building, Abolishing Global Slavery, Education ~ The Coats are jointly appointed missionaries of IM and HOPE. From their home in Chiang Rai, Thailand, they support Thai nationals in their own ministries as they seek to impact the lives of the ethnic minority peoples who inhabit the hills of northern Thailand, the Eastern Shan State of Myanmar, and neighboring countries. These partner organizations empower communities to organize for social and economic change.

SBC Missionaries: Clinton Patronella (Lead Church Planter, Seven Mile Road, Waltman, Mass.) ~ Seven Mile Road is a new church, where neighbors become family. They believe that the church is not a building or place, but a family and a community. Their big dream is to saturate Waltham with the gospel until everyone delights in the truth, goodness, and beauty of Jesus.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: Adam Harwood/Military Chaplaincy, New Orleans, LA ~ Adam has been on the seminary at the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary in 2013. He serves as associate professor of theology, director of the Baptist Center for Theology and Ministry, and editor of the Journal of Baptist Theology and Ministry. In 2017, he was commissioned as a Chaplain in the Louisiana Army National Guard.
