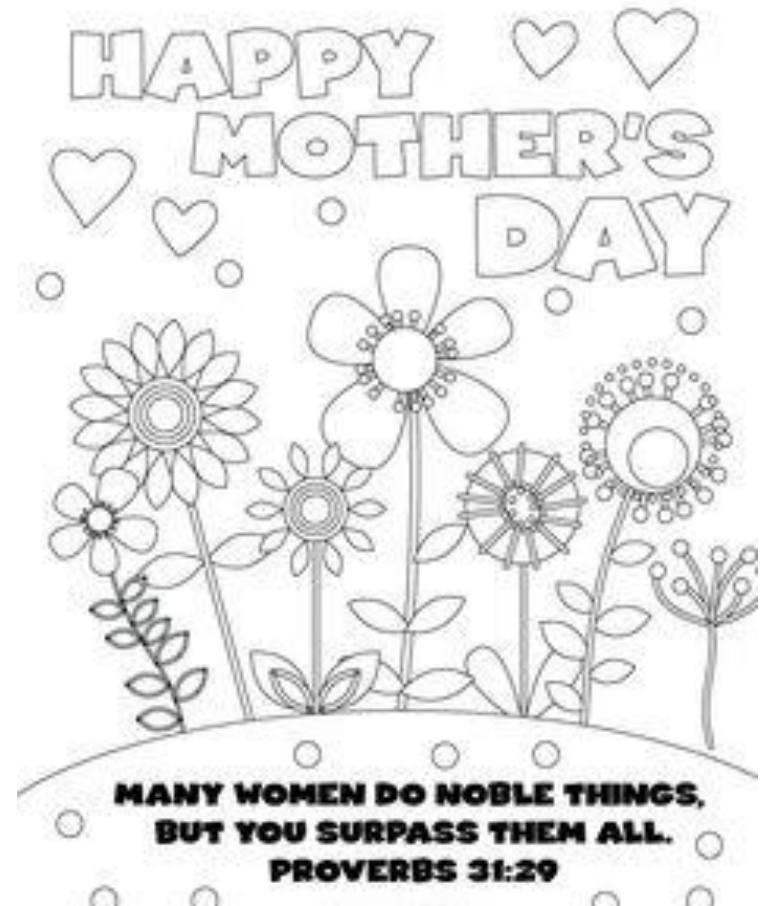

ABC International Ministries: Jill & Mike Lowery | Democratic Republic of the Congo ~

The Lowerys work with the Congolese Baptist Community (CBCO), continuing the efforts American Baptists began in the Democratic Republic of the Congo more than a century ago. Mike works to equip leaders for ministry in rural churches in the Bandundu region of Congo and is a pastor of the International Protestant Church of Kinshasa.
