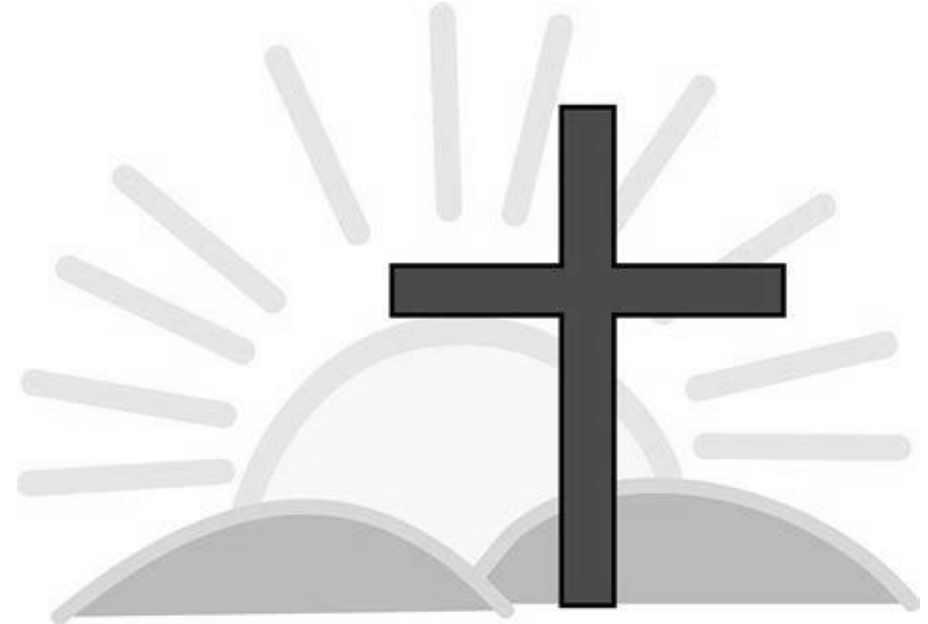

Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Ed and Miriam Noyes serve in the **Democratic Republic of the Congo**, where over two-thirds of the population depends on agriculture for a living, over half of all rural women can't read or write and chronic malnutrition limits the lives of many children. Working with the Baptist Convention of Congo and IMA World Health, they encourage and support church-based programs contributing to basic food security, improved family livelihoods, creation of new opportunities through literacy and strengthening rural churches.

SBC Missionaries: David Orweller (Church at H20 City/Columbus, OH) ~ A team from Michigan planted H20 at Ohio State University in 2008, hoping to reach OSU students with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Since then, God has expanded their vision to include graduate, professionals, children, and in Columbus as well. That's where the H20 City plant comes in. They have begun the process of planting the H20 City congregation just off OSU's campus by forming life groups and cultivating community and mission, and they officially launched in November 2016.

SBC Chaplaincy: Lieutenant Antony Kaniaru, CHC, Chaplain, U.S. Navy, Based: Naval Air Station, Jacksonville, FL ~ Pray for the Command Chaplain and him as they attend to military and civilian on base and retirees in the Jacksonville area. Pray for good health, strength, wisdom, and words to speak.
