**ABC International Ministries: Laura & Rich Freeman/Discipleship/Turkey**

~The Freemans are associate development workers jointly appointed with International Ministries and their nonprofit organization, Turkish Connection International. They serve in the establishment of new churches in one of the least-reached countries on earth: Turkey. They work with Turkish pastors and key Christian leaders to accomplish three goals: first, identifying new potential pastors that are well-trained and highly respected; second, gathering needed financial support for these pastors; and third, maintaining ongoing contact with each new church, engaging and nurturing the pastors.

**SBC Missionaries: Austin Smith/Lead Church Planter/ Capital Community Church, Barre, VT**

~ Capital Community Church grew out of a men's Bible study that met at a local restaurant. After several months the group brought their wives, and the group began meeting in the Smith's home. In October of 2015, the group rented space from the Episcopal Church in town and officially formed Capital Community Church.
