Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Dan & Sharon Buttry/Global

Consultant/Peace & Justice ~ Dan works with International Ministries missionaries and national church partners around the world to deal constructively with conflict situations. These conflicts may be social and political conflicts within a country or within the national church bodies that negatively impact Christian witness. Sharon has been endorsed for a special appointment to serve part-time as a global consultant for community transformation. In this ministry, Sharon will provide consultation and training of community and conflict transformation at the request of American Baptist International MInistries' global partners, primarily in coordination with and complementing the work of her husband, Dan Buttry.

SBC Missionaries: Spencer Parish (Serving as Lead Church Planter, Calvary Church, Kearney, Nebraska) ~ He and his wife have been called to this thriving town of 30,000, and growing, with a university of 7,000 students. The University of Nebraska at Kearney has a reputation as a party school, and their hearts break for the students who are drinking from muddy wells of their own creation, rather than drinking from the well of living water. The southern half of Kearney is much less affluent than the northern half of town, and desperately needs a new church. .

SBC Chaplaincy: Lieutenant Antony Kaniaru, CHC, Chaplain, U.S. Navy, Based: Naval Air Station, Jacksonville, FL ~ Pray for the Command Chaplain and him as they attend to military and civilian on base and retirees in the Jacksonville area. Pray for good health, strength, wisdom, and words to speak.
