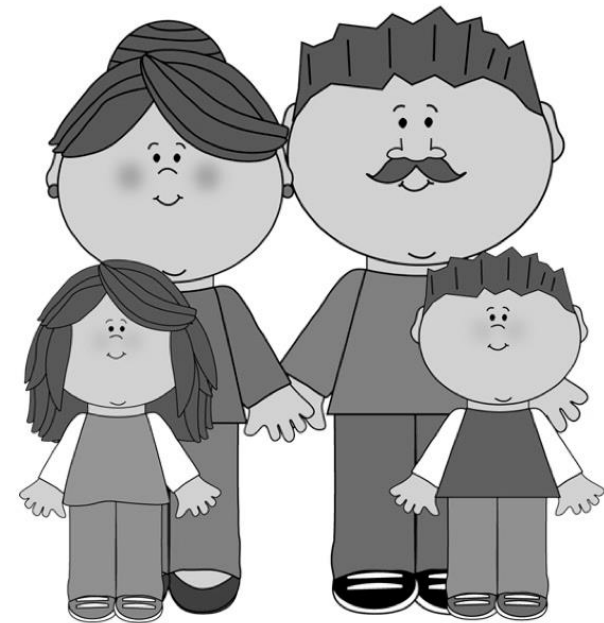

ABC International Ministries: Kyle & Debby Witmer/Thailand ~ The Witmers have been commissioned to serve the Thai Karen Baptist Convention's (TKBC) Siloam Bible Institute in Chiang Mai, Thailand, where they work in pastoral education and leadership development. Karen young people attend the school with the goal of following the call of God on their lives to be pastors and evangelists among the Karen villages in the hills of Thailand. Kyle is also involved in continuing education with TKBC pastors and evangelists, while Debby is seeking out new ministry opportunities. The Witmers continue discipleship with their own children through homeschooling.

SBC Missionaries: Ivey & Allie Rhodes (Lead Church Planter, Mosaic Boston, Jamaica Plain, (JP) Boston, Massachusetts) ~ Jamaica Plain is one of Boston's most diverse neighborhoods and values community more than anything. Though JP desires community, displacement and gentrification have left many alienated and hurt. Many in JP believer political activism will solve these issues, but Ivey & Allie know that the gospel is the true answer for a unified community. They believe that JP is ripe for the true community found in Christ and His church, and desire to plant a church that wins the lost and reflects the diversity of the neighborhood and the true love found in Christ.
