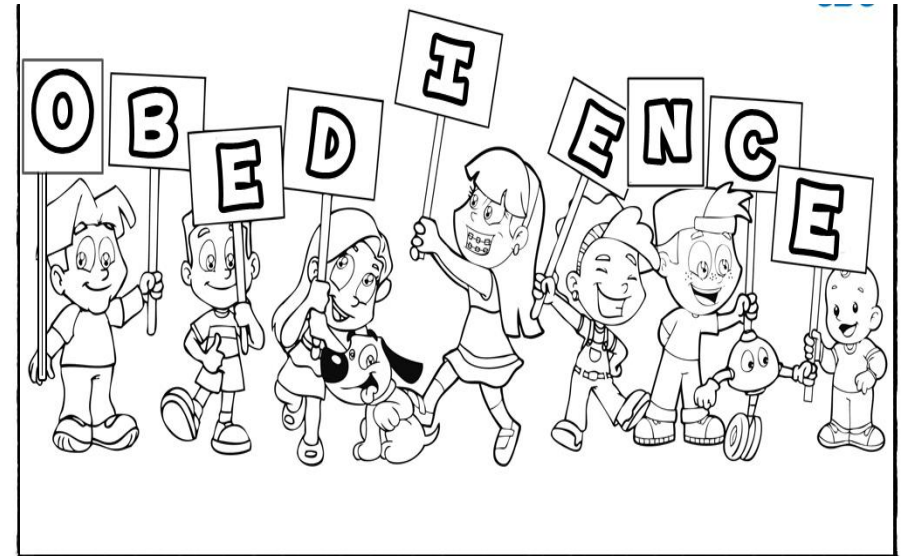

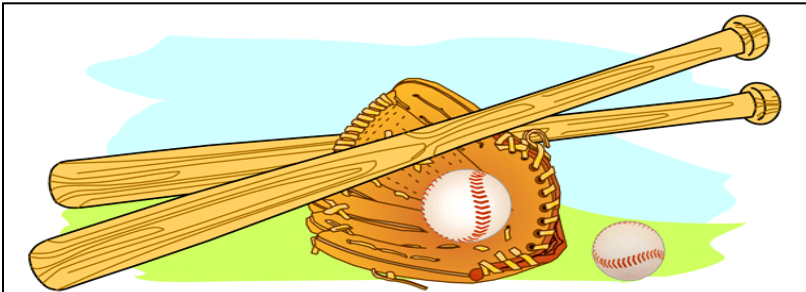

Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Kristy Engel (Dominican Republic; Lebanon) Kristy Engel is a global consultant with a focus on health care issues. She served for 12 years in the Dominican Republic, leading mobile medical clinics and International Ministries relief efforts following the 2010 Haiti earthquake. One of the newest projects she has is that of joining with the health care education initiative for local leaders in Lebanon. She will be partnering with Crossroads Baptist Church in the Denver area and several local organizations working with the marginalized and immigrant populations throughout Lebanon.

SBC Missionaries: Brandon Langley (Lead Church Planter, St. Rose Community Church, St. Rose, Louisiana) ~ After years of decline at the First Baptist Church in St. Rose, the 10 in attendance made the brave choice of donating all their property to FBC Kenner, so a new kingdom work could begin. In 2016, they set out with a small core team to start a new church in an old building with a weekly time of **Sunday** evening prayer. In two-year's time, Brandon Langley has seen 25 people from the community profess faith in Christ and have already seen several of these converts serve on the international mission field.
