Tim serves in leadership development with the Baja Baptist Seminary of Mexicali, teaching present and future church leaders in Baja California, México; and with IM partners in the Dominican Republic.

**SBC Missionaries: Ryan Rice (Lead Church Planter, Connect Church, New Orleans, LA)** ~ Connect Church exists to make disciples, glorify Christ, and serve the city. It is a multiethnic and generational church in the community of Algiers. Since their church began, they have placed great emphasis on being an outwardly focused church. They have also partnered with local community groups and ministries to assist in reaching the city with the love of Christ. Their prayer is that they can continue to reach their community and make disciples who make disciples.

**SBC CHAPLAINCY: Michael Leskowat/Army Chaplaincy in KS/Pastor in OK** ~ Michael serves as the Battalion Chaplain for the 329th Combat Sustainment Support Battalion bases in Parson, Kansas.
