Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Boaz Keibarak/Evangelism, Discipleship, Peace & Justice/Kenya ~ Boaz has served in Kenya through the Kingdom of Peace & Development (KOPAD) organization for over a decade. He provides conflict transformation training, mediation, and reconciliation among the rural communities throughout east Kenya along the border of western Uganda, as well as working in ministries of evangelism, church planting, and discipleship with new believers. Boaz serves with IM as an International Associate Global Servant.

SBC Missionaries: Abbey Caudell/Church Planting Team Member/Lakeshore Church, New Orleans, Louisiana ~ In 2010, Abbey felt the Lord call her to ministry, and in 2016, she fell in love with missions. When she found GenSend, a six-week internship in one of the 32 Send Cities, she decided to devote that summer to missions. During that time, their Send City missionary, George Ross, announced they would be planting a new church in the Bucktown area of New Orleans. This is where she found her new church home and began serving in student and children's ministries, as well as being part of the worship team. Through that, she became a NAMB church planting partner and stepped into her new role as mission team and volunteer director.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: Scott Brown/Military Chaplaincy/ Army Chapel, Washington, D.C. ~ Scott served in the active and reserve/national guard military for more than 33 years as an enlisted man, as an officer, as a helicopter pilot, and now as a chaplain. He and his family love hosting Bible studies, teaching the Word, and preaching/singing/helping on Sundays as well.
