Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Kihomi Ngwemi & Nzunga Mabudiga/Haiti ~ Kihomi and Nzunga serve as a vital link between International Ministries and the Haitian Baptist Convention. Nzunga teaches theology at the Christian University of Northern Haiti, trains assistant professors and administers a scholarship program for elementary- through university-age students. He manages the goat and pig projects for children, the clean water project for communities and the Cap-Haitian Eye Clinic. Kihomi works in counseling, women's health, community health evangelism and economic development. She coordinates and advises the women's association of the convention, representing women of all the Baptist denominations of Haiti at international conferences.

SBC Missionaries: Robby Pitt/Lead Church Planter/The Peak Church/Louisville, CO ~ Robb is praying for a ripe harvest, receptive people, person of peace/influence, a passionate love for God/people, local roots, showing/telling the Good News, modeling/teaching how to follow Jesus in real life and a growing group of Jesus followers and curious explorers to form The Peak Church. Plans are being made to plant three additional churches in their county.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: Marc Unger/Military Chaplaincy/First Baptist Church of Madera/Madera, CA ~ Marc has been in pastoral ministry since 1983. He is currently the senior pastor at First Baptist Church of Madera, CA. He joined the California State Guard December 4, 2004, as Chaplain for the 1-185th Infantry. He and his wife Lynda are *Gold Star parents as their son, SPC Daniel Paul Unger, gave his life in saving two Iraqi civilians on May 25, 2004. Marc's call was confirmed following the preaching of their son's memorial.* Marc is currently serving as Battalion Chaplain within the California State Guard
