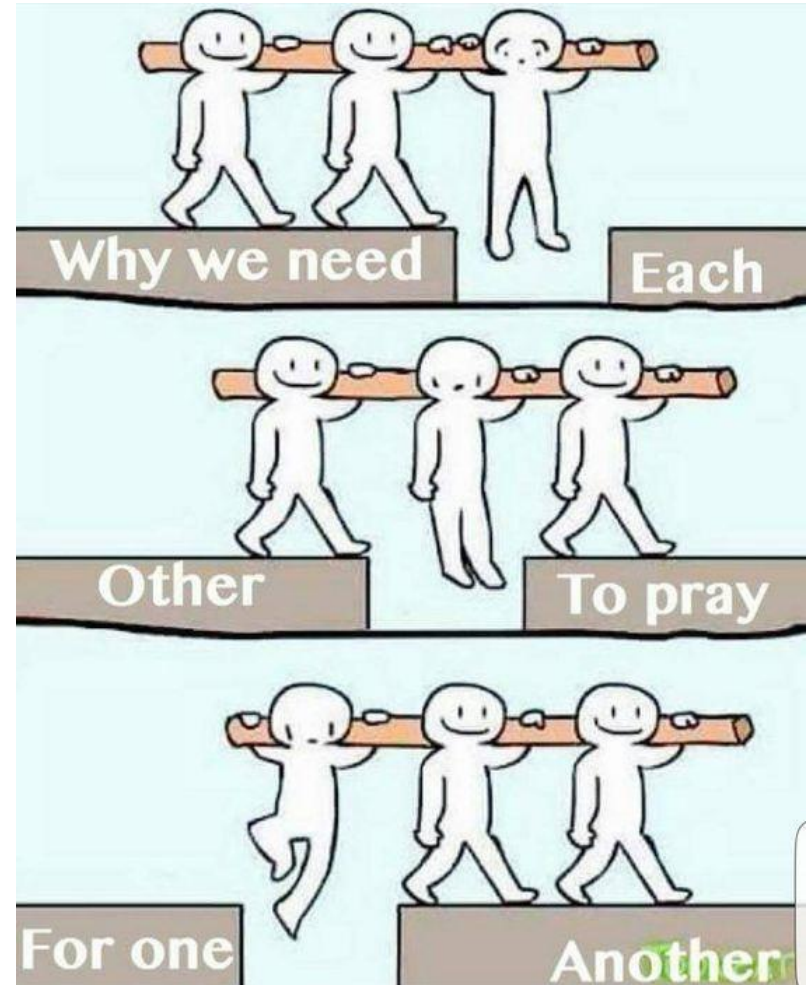

ABC International Ministries: Patti and Tim Long/Theological Education; Education/Baja, CA ~ Tim serves in leadership development with the Baja Baptist Seminary of Mexicali, teaching present and future church leaders in Baja, CA, Mexico; and with IM partners in the Dominican Republic. Patti ministers as a special education teacher and resource specialist at the Monte Horeb Baptist Grade School in Tijuana, a school that reaches out to the most vulnerable of the city's young population, its children.

SBC Missionaries: Jeremy Roth (Lead Church Planter, Merriman Road Baptist Church, Michigan) Church Plant: Redeemer Community Church is a gospel-centered confessional church leading people to turn and follow Jesus Christ. They are committed to the mission of making disciples of Jesus in Dearborn, Michigan and throughout southeast Michigan. People are lead to repentance and equipped to increasingly follow Him in all life, by inviting them to do life-on-life, life in community, and life on mission together with them. Their primary outreach is done at Whitmore-Bolles elementary school in Dearborn, where they work with students, teachers, and parents. They also run a sports league that reaches more than 100 kids.
